

**B. Important vocabulary not covered in *From Alpha to Omega*:**

(Note: some of these words are also absent from *Athenaze*.)

**verbs:**

αΐρω, ἀρῶ, ἤρα, ἤρκα, ἤρμαι, ἤρθην lift, raise up; intrans. set out  
 ἀπόλλυμι, ἀπολῶ, ἀπώλεσα (destroy), ἀπολώλεκα (I have ruined) ἀπόλωλα  
 (I am ruined)  
 καθίστημι (compound of κατα + ἵστημι), when transitive, I set X up; I appoint X; + εἰς  
 + acc., I put X into a certain state; when intransitive, I am appointed; I am  
 established; + εἰς + acc., I get/fall into a certain state; I become (idiom  
 εἰς ἀπορίαν καθίσταμαι to fall into perplexity, become perplexed or at a loss)  
 θάπτω, θάψω, ἔθαψα, τέθαμμαι, ἐτάφην bury  
 λαγχάνω, λήξομαι, ἔλαχον, εἶληχα, εἶληγμαι, ἐλήχθην obtain by lot; usually used  
 with supplementary participle  
 στέλλω, στελῶ, ἔστειλα, ἔσταλκα, ἔσταλμαι, ἐστάλην send  
 τρέφω, θρέψω, ἔθρεψα, τέτροφα, τέθραμμαι, ἐτρέφην support, nourish  
 φθάνω, φθήσομαι, ἔφθασα or ἐφθην to anticipate, to arrive before someone (+ acc.);  
 usually used with supplementary participle
